- Delays in project delivery (project cargo interruption).

Supply Chain Management overview

This provides an overview of your entire cargo operation, identifying vulnerabilities and possible areas of improvement along the supply chain.

Features and benefits:

- We meet with your key personnel to gain knowledge of your operations, reviewing your distribution strategy.
- Interviews and investigation are required to complete the work, including input from the risk manager, logistics/operations manager.
- This enables us to understand the areas of risk right across your operation.

Outcomes and next steps

You receive a comprehensive presentation outlining the findings and recommendations, including further investigative work that is required.

The overview establishes the priorities for reducing the key risks and feeds into a management action plan. We can help you develop a program of further assessment and risk reduction activities e.g. surveys of critical operations and sites.

Site risk assessment

The assessment of storage and distribution locations is designed to protect assets and control losses whilst they are in storage. It includes an analysis of the risk for the goods in storage as well as the loading delivery and distribution procedures of the site concerned.

Features and benefits:

- We assess the physical attributes of the location as well as reviewing your procedures for storage and distribution.
- We visit onsite, surveying and assessing, including input from the warehouse and logistics/operations managers. We then collate the findings into a report and presentation.
- This enables us to identify and highlight the areas of risk for the particular location.

Outcomes and next steps

You receive a comprehensive presentation outlining the findings and recommendations, including loss prevention advice.

The assessment establishes the priorities for reducing the key risks and feeds into a management action plan. We can help you develop a program of further assessment and risk reduction activities e.g. procedural development.

Logistics assessment

The assessment of a particular logistics area is designed to protect assets and control losses whilst they are in transit. It includes an analysis of the risk for both the goods in storage as well as the handling procedures. It can focus on:

- Third party suppliers.
- Particular areas of the operation e.g. temperature controlled areas.
- Packaging.

Features and benefits:

- We look at specific areas of the logistics operation that are of particular concern or are critical to the overall operation.
- We work with your key people to review the processes and procedures in place, and review the third party service level agreements.
- This enables us to identify and highlight the areas of risk for the particular logistics area.

Outcomes and next steps

You receive a comprehensive presentation outlining the findings and recommendations, including loss prevention advice.

The assessment establishes the priorities for reducing the key risks and feeds into a management action plan. We can help you develop a program of further risk reduction activities e.g. procedural development and third party service level agreement production.

Post-loss assessment

Our post-loss assessments are designed to analyse trends and propose loss lessons with advice and recommendations to reduce either the frequency or severity of future incidents.

Features and benefits:

- We work closely with our claims experts to analyse trends over time, as well as thoroughly reviewing particular losses.
- We work with your key people to review the processes and procedures in place, and review the third party service level agreements.
- Post-loss surveys are designed to provide guidance on proactive loss prevention after a significant claim or where the risk profile/loss ratio causes particular concern.

Outcomes and next steps

You receive a comprehensive presentation outlining the findings and recommendations for future loss prevention.

The survey establishes the priorities for reducing the key risks and feeds into a management action plan. We can help you develop a program of further risk reduction activities e.g. procedural development and loss prevention strategies.

Project cargo risk services

Project cargo risks are a specific area of expertise in which our specialist are highly experienced. Our services and the makeup of the program are dependant upon the type of project cargo, but can include analysis and advice on:

- The risk posed by the project.
- Sourcing of the equipment.
- Transport routes and location/layout of the project.
- Outlining modules that are considered critical due to their value and/or replacement time, or their dimensions or transport method.
- Identifying potential risk areas within the supply chain where this may have an impact on case e.g. port blockages, strikes, transport routes, vessel capabilities.

- We can support you throughout the project, from the initial desk review on submission for cover, to critical milestones throughout the project, through to completion.
- We work with you to ensure that the risks are minimised to an acceptable level and managed throughout the duration of the transportation of the project items.
