

Zurich gibt vorzeitige Rückzahlung nachrangiger Anleihe bekannt

Zürich, 27. Juni 2014 – Zurich Insurance Group (Zurich) hat heute mitgeteilt, dass sie die Option der vorzeitigen Rückzahlung einer nachrangigen Anleihe von EUR 143 Millionen ausgeübt hat.

Die nachrangige Anleihe von EUR 143 Millionen mit unbegrenzter Laufzeit wurde im Juli 2009 von Zurich Insurance Company Ltd im Rahmen des von ihr aufgelegten „Euro Medium Term Note Programme“ ausgegeben. Sie wird am 15. Juli 2014 zum Nennwert vorzeitig zurückbezahlt, zuzüglich aufgelaufener Zinsen.
